



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Connect the handle to the flange. Nuts go on handle side of flange.
- 2. Use (4) 3/8" or 10 mm bolts when securing the hose reel to ceiling or wall.
- 3. Use the provided nuts, bolts and mounting bracket when securing hose reel to a cart.
- 4. Use thread sealant (not provided) on inlet threads and on outlet hose (not provided).
- 5. Attach hose from high pressure pump outlet to hose reel inlet.
- 6. Attach hose reel hose to swivel on hose reel
- 7. The hose reel is ready for operation.

- 1. Make sure incoming pressure does not exceed the rated pressure.
- 2. Use proper eye protection when assembling and using the hose reel.
